

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST SPARTA, COUNTY OF STARK AND STATE OF OHIO HELD IN THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING ON OCTOBER 18, 2010.

Meeting called to order at 7:00pm. Mayor Truax led Council and visitors in reciting The Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken with the following members present; Mayor Jackie Truax, Council Members Charlene Stelluto, Chris Freitag, Marlene Gray and Jenna Hessedence. Absent was Clerk-Treasurer Rice. Hessedence made motion to accept the absence, seconded by Stelluto. Roll call 4 Yea, 0 Nay, motion carried. Visitors included; Ron Prosperi, Bob Cyperski (Village Solicitor) and Barb Malavite (SVCP).

The Police Report was presented to Council. For September there were; 1 Traffic Arrest, 0 Juvenile Traffic, 0 DUI Arrest, 1 Crash Report, 3 Misdemeanor Arrests, 0 Felony Arrests and 3 Calls for Service.

Mayor Truax reminded Council that Trick or Treat will be October 29th from 6-7:00pm.

The minutes of the September 20th meeting were read. Freitag made motion to accept the minutes as read, seconded by Hessedence. Roll call 4 Yea, 0 Nay, motion carried.

The Financial Reports were presented to Council. The reports included; Warrant Register, Receipt Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status, Bank Reconciliation and Appropriation Status. Stelluto made motion to pay the bills totaling \$24,352.03, seconded by Freitag. Roll call 4 Yea, 0 Nay, motion carried.

Freitag made motion to accept the resolution as presented, seconded by Hessedence. Roll call 4 Yea, 0 Nay, motion carried.

R-21-10-10 resolution requesting Amended Certificate and Supplemental Appropriations in the amount of \$750.00 for donation received for Boo. Freitag made motion to suspend three readings, seconded by Stelluto. Roll call 4 Yea, 0 Nay, motion carried. Freitag made motion to accept the resolution as presented, seconded by Gray. Roll call 4 Yea, 0 Nay, motion carried.

The Mayor informed Council that Boo in the Park was a success again this year and wanted to thank all who volunteered and participated.

The Mayor reminded Council to educate the residents of the need to pass the levy on the November 2nd ballot. Stelluto made a flyer that will be disbursed prior to the election.

Cyperski reported that he will be filing the annexation petitions in Stark and Tuscarawas Counties this Friday.

Malavite reported that there were no Park Board Minutes, but did say that the park had a good year and discussions are underway to improve next year.

The Water Board minutes were presented to Council. The run reports for the Fire Dept. and Tri-division were presented to Council.

The Christmas Parade will be on November 20th at 10:00am.
